 All entries in these classes must be properly identified on the entry form under "Additional classes" (i.e. "Breed" or "Brood Bitch"). Entries in Breed are considered a unit and each entrant must be listed.
 The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with not more than 3 of the get or produce and be entered in the class. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch does not need to be the owner of the get or produce.
STUD DOG CLASS - For dogs that have stud at least two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award is based on the merits of the get.
BROOD BITCH CLASS - For bitches that have whelped at least two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award is based on the merits of the produce.

PARADE OF VETERANS - THURSDAY AFTERNOON ONLY

This non-competitive event is for all dogs 7 years and older. A Rosette lettered with the dog's name on 15" streamers will be presented. Fee is \$18.00 and the dog does not have to be entered in any other class. Complete an entry form and attach a brief summary to be read aloud as the dog is presented.

DOBERMAN PINSCHER PUPPY - SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee is \$18.00. All entries in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class in this show. Entries shall be made at the same time on the same entry form used for the regular class. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the appropriate sex and age in the space provided for Additional Classes.

This Sweepstakes is open to all Dobermans who, on the day of the show, will be six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age. Dogs entered in the Sweepstakes can be shown by anyone: owner, amateur or professional handler. Dogs that have attained their championship are NOT eligible to be shown in the Sweepstakes.

DIVISION OF PRIZE MONEY

The Desert Valley Doberman Pinscher Club will retain 35% of the total receipts to defray expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows: One-half of each net division stake shall be divided, one-quarter to the dogs and one-quarter to the bitches as follows:

40% to First Place in each class 20% to Third Place in each class
30% to Second Place in each class 10% to Fourth Place in each class

All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show rules.

THIS SHOW is governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the entry blank in this Premium List.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and Photocopies of entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

NO ENTRY CAN BE ACCEPTED that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Telegraph or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors after closing date.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in an exercise pen. There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show.

DESERT VALLEY DOBERMAN PINSCHER CLUB, INC. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee or because dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

THE CLUB AND ITS Show Secretary will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog or the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the Show premises. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE at any time prior to scheduled time of judging of their class. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Owners or handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. There is no rule of this Club or the AKC that requires a Judge to wait for a dog.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over, and the Show Secretary advised at once.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES: A Recording Fee of 50¢, Event Services Fee of \$3.00 and a Rally Fee of \$3.00 will be required for Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience or Tracking Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

TRANSFER OF ENTRY TO BEST OF BREED: Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship or Obedience Title after the closing of entries but whose Title is unconfirmed may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition or more advanced Obedience Class, provided this transfer is made with the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of regular conformation judging at the show.
