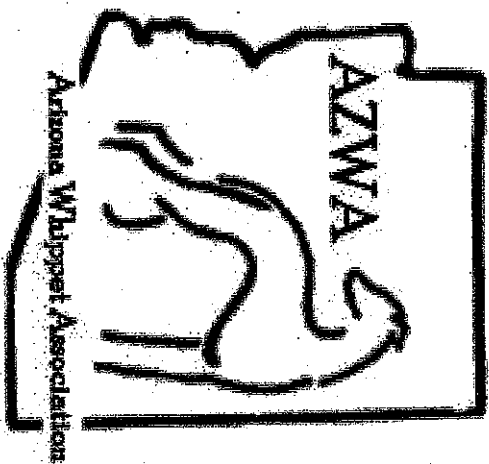

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 1:00 p.m. on Wed, March 3, 2010. Dogs must be removed immediately following Best in Show judging of Superstition Kennel Club show on Mon, March 8, 2010. THIS SHOW is governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the entry blank in this Premium List.  
ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and Photographs of entry Terms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.  
NO ENTRY CAN BE ACCEPTED that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Telegraph or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors after closing date.  
ARIZONA WHIPPET ASSOCIATION may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Breed Show Committee or because dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing.  
RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

THE CLUB AND ITS SHOW SECRETARY will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog or possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes. It is understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on Show premises. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the exhibitor's responsibility and it is expressly understood exhibitors will exercise control and restraint of their children at all times.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE at any time prior to scheduled time of judging of their class. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Owners or handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. There is no rule of this Club or AKC that requires a judge to wait for a dog.

CLASS CASH PRIZES to be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for cash prize must be made in the ring before judging of the breed is over, and Show Secretary advised at once.  
RECORDING & EVENT FEES: Recording Fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 Event Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience or Tracking Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-gyming Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2.) TRANSFER OF ENTRY TO BEST OF BREED: Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries but whose Championships are unconfirmed may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made with the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of regular conformation judging at the show.

### DAY OF SHOW PARKING

Day of Show Parking fees are at WestWorld's discretion and collected upon arrival at the gate. Fee for each automobile space occupied is \$5 per entrance. Vehicles occupying more than one space will be charged and located accordingly. A multi-day pass allowing unlimited exit & entrance is available for \$20 at the gate or on-line at [festiacluster.com/parking](http://festiacluster.com/parking). Vehicles occupying more than one space will be charged accordingly. Parking attendants will direct exhibitors to designated areas on asphalt & gravel lots. NO PARKING OR DRIVING ON THE GRASS. Unloading zone will be provided with a 10-minute time limit. You may NOT take your dogs and equipment to the ring and you may NOT take vehicles on the show grounds. You must unload them immediately back your vehicle. There will be NO REGULAR EXHIBITOR PARKING IN RESERVED AREAS or any area designated as OFFICIAL FIRE ZONE or NO PARKING ZONE. Limited hand-dropped day of show parking is available on a "first come" basis. Exhibitors not abiding by the rules may be subject to a Show Committee Hearing and having their vehicles towed from the area or ticketed.

### GENERATORS/MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Power for grooming tents and setups is provided by Fiesta Cluster. NO OTHER PORTABLE GENERATORS will be allowed on the pole field. NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES shall be operated in the aisles between rings or within 20 feet of any ring.

### GOLF CART USAGE DURING SHOW HOURS

Only carts allowed in the vicinity of show rings will be officially marked for Fiesta Cluster Committee use only. Private golf carts will be restricted to traffic on outside perimeter of the Show Boundaries designated as the Fire Lanes.

### GROOMING & SETUPS

Fiesta Cluster will designate public Grooming tents and set up areas and Fiesta Cluster Committee members will supervise the grooming/grading areas. They will be available to assist and enforce the setup starting Wednesday, February 23, 2009 at 1pm. Public Grooming Tents with power are provided for exhibitor use on a first-come/first-served basis. Exhibitors are not permitted to mark off or reserve space in the public grooming tents in any manner. Exercise pens are not permitted under Public Grooming Tents. Aides will be designated in public grooming tents/set up areas and must be maintained. Fiesta Cluster Committee reserves the right to require space in Public Grooming tents be optimized and may require that crates be stacked. No vending may take place under any public grooming tent. Personal setups (EZ-top, canopy tents) are permitted in areas designated by Fiesta Cluster. No setups permitted within 20 feet of any ring. No crates, exercise pens, grooming tables, or setups will be allowed in the aisles. The Fiesta Cluster Committee will make every effort to ensure these policies are enforced and setups are consolidated to accommodate as many exhibitors as possible in Public Grooming Tent/set up area. Please note: Some Specialty Clubs have private tenting for their exclusive use. All public-grooming tents will be clearly marked and may be used by all exhibitors. THE ARIZONA WHIPPET ASSOCIATION IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OR INJURY DUE TO TENTING NOT PROVIDED BY THE FIESTA CLUSTER.

### SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING RINGSIDE SHADE TENTS - RINGSIDE GRATING

Shaded Areas at ringside is for exhibitors' convenience while their breed is being exhibited. Exhibitors can occupy this area no sooner than 15 minutes prior to scheduled exhibition time, or later than 15 minutes after completion of their breed judging. NO GROOMING, SETUPS OR EXERCISE PENS WILL BE PERMITTED AT RINGSIDE. Dogs may not be left unattended in RINGSIDE shaded areas while that breed is currently being exhibited. Show Committee will impound dogs left in violation of this regulation. Owners/agents who violate these regulations, or whose dogs the Show Committee has impounded will be subject to disciplinary action as exacted the Sportstable Dog Fanciers Association, Inc. and/or Superstition Kennel Club, Inc. Show Committee. Expenses incurred thereof will be the owner's responsibility.

### DOGS LEFT IN PARKED CARS

In the event it becomes necessary to rescue an animal from a parked car on the show grounds or parking areas immediately surrounding the show grounds, neither Fiesta Cluster nor Arizona Whippet Association will be held liable for any damages incurred as a result of rescuing the animals. If the rescue is performed by virtue of negligence, the owner, agent or any other person responsible for the rescued animal WILL be subject to a Bench Show Hearing, as approved by the AKC rules.

### MAJOR RULES & REGULATIONS

It is against Scottsdale regulations and ordinances for any person or organization to bring upon the premises any alcoholic beverages unless a permit has been purchased from Scottsdale Parks and Recreation. Trainers and fines may be imposed for non-compliance. NO glass containers are allowed on the property.

Bathrooms and Showers are available for exhibitors located above the NE corner of the Pole Field. Any exhibitor found with a dog in bathrooms or showers will NOT be allowed to exhibit and will be subject to action by the SHOW COMMITTEE. A sanitary dump station is available on the grounds.

This Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

**Veteran Classes** - For dogs and bitches 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Classes will be divided: 7-10 years and 10 years and over. Sexes divided. The winners of these classes will compete for Best of Breed  
**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES - (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.  
The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the get or produce and be entered in the class. Neutered Dogs and spayed bitches may be shown in these classes. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch does not need to be the owner of the get or produce. Stud Dog and Get, Brood Bitch and Produce constitute one entry.  
**STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dogs and no more than two of their get. Get must be entered in one of the regular classes in this show. The award is based on the merits of the get.  
**BROOD BITCH CLASS** - For Brood Bitches and no more than two of their produce. Produce must be entered in one of the regular classes of this show. The award is based on the merits of the produce.

**BRACE CLASS** - Shall be for two Whippets, irrespective of sex, with at least ONE owner the same. At least one brace Whippet must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or in some non-regular class other than Brace. Those desiring to show in Brace Class must write "BRACE" on the entry form in the space provided for "Additional Classes." If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must be designated as "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc. Spayed or neutered Whippets are eligible.

### Whippet Puppy Sweepstakes

Entry fee - \$15.00. Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Whippets who, on the day of the show, will be six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age. **CHAMPIONS OF RECORD MAY COMPLETE.** Entries in Puppy Sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class in this show. Entries shall be made at the same time on the same entry form used for the regular class. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the appropriate sex and age in the space provided for Additional Classes. First place in each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes.

### DIRECTIONS TO WESTWORLD

**From the North (Flagstaff)** - I-17 South to SR-101 loop East into Scottsdale. Take Pima/Princess exit. Turn left at Bell Road (second light) and continue East on Bell Road. Turn right on 94th Street. Travel South to WestWorld Entrance, turn right and follow to Dog Show.

**West (California)** - I-10 East to SR-101 loop North (near Tolleson). Remain on SR-101 across I-17 and continue into Scottsdale. Take Pima/Princess exit and follow directions above

**South (Tucson)** - I-10 to SR-202 loop (San Tan Freeway). SR-202 East to SR-101 loop. SR-101 North to Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd exit. Move to far right lane. Continue straight, crossing Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd. Intersection. Stay in right lane, WestWorld entrance is on top of hill. Turn right at horse statue and follow road to Show.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.
